

Grass



Description

There are several types of grass, depending on the desired result, the soil, the location, etc. Cultivation is relatively easy, provided the soil is properly prepared previously.

Watering



Water regularly to keep the soil moist.



Watering should be carried out mainly in light showers, so that water does not stagnate and seeds don't move.

Sowing

1 Till the soil to a depth of around 15 to 20 cm using a rototiller, motor hoe or spade. Refine the soil and remove all stones, roots and weeds. Level and compact the soil.

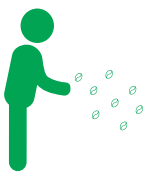


Maintenance

Mow regularly, except during dry spells. For first mowing, wait until the blades of grass are at least 10 cm high. The lawn should be well covered.

Sowing

2 Broadcast the seeds in a criss-cross pattern: one part in one direction, the other part perpendicular. Use a lawn roller to bury the seeds or a rake to scrape a few millimetres of soil. Water in a fine rain.



Tips

How to protect seeds from birds?

Birds love seedlings, so if you want a uniform crop, here are a few solutions: install bird-proof netting for small areas, at around 10 cm from the ground, install a water- and air-permeable wintering veil, audible or visual scarecrows or a cat.
